Re: Update on Equestrian competitions at the 20th Asian Games
Aichi-Nagoya 2026

Dear Sir/Madam,

The Olympic Council of Asia (OCA) would like to inform all National Olympic Committees (NOCs) about the updated details regarding the Equestrian competitions at the 20th Asian Games Aichi-Nagoya 2026.

A total of seven medal competition events will be held in the Equestrian, as listed below:

- Eventing, Team Competition
- Eventing, Individual Competition
- Dressage, Team Competition
- Dressage, Individual Competition
- Jumping, Team Competition (**heights of 1.40-145 m**)
- Jumping, Individual Competition (**heights of 1.40-1.50 m**)
- Jumping, Individual Competition (**heights of 1.50-1.55 m**)

Relevant remarks:

- 1) The combinations participating in the Individual Competition (**heights of 1.50-1.55 m**) must submit their Certificate of Capability by the Nomination Entry deadline (the exact date will be disclosed with the Entries Policy).

- 2) The NOC must declare, at the Nomination Entry, a Jumping Individual Event in which the athlete will compete. Riders are not permitted to participate in both events.

About the Minimum Eligibility Requirements (MER)

Achieve the following qualifying result (MER) as a combination is mandatory combination who will take part in the Individual Competition (**heights of 1.50-1.55**):

- at one minimum CSI2* event, 1m45 Table A: 4 penalties or less, AND
- at one minimum CSI3* event, 1m50 Table A: 8 penalties or less.


CSI1*-W competitions with a height of 1.45m or 1.50m will also be accepted as competitions to achieve the qualifying results above. Both results need to be achieved at two (2) different events.

The period to obtain MER: 1 January 2025 - to date of nominated entries
There is no restriction for combinations that have participated at the W_CH or OG or obtained an MER for CH-M-S between 1 January 2025 and the date of nominated entries.

FEI will provide support for wildcards for Jumping events

Further details and additional information will be made available by the Aichi- Nagoya Organizing Committee (AINAGOC) and published in the Technical Handbook.”
